



COIL: Inclusive education

COIL, what is it?



[Collaborative Online International Learning \(COIL\)](#) is the term that we use to refer to "virtual mobility" experiences that are embedded into the formal curriculum and provide students with an opportunity to interact with peers at international universities and professionals, so they can develop intercultural competences and digital skills while working together on subject-specific learning tasks or activities.

There are 4 key elements that define any COIL project:

1. It involves a cross-border collaboration or interaction with people from different backgrounds and cultures.
2. Students must engage in some sort of online interaction, whether it is asynchronous or synchronous.
3. It must be driven by a set of internationalised learning outcomes aimed at developing global perspectives and/or fostering students' intercultural competences.
4. There must be a reflective component that helps students think critically about such interactions.

Inclusion of "Hidden figures"



The goal of our cooperation is to explore the topic of inclusive education. There are students from the [Faculty of Education](#), Masaryk University (Brno, Czech Republic), and students from [Vinnitsia State Pedagogical University](#) (Vinnitsia, Ukraine). We will explore the main topic all together, in smaller groups (of 5), and individually as well.

What should we gain from this cooperation? We hope you can gain inspiration on how the educational system in another country works. You will be able to plan independently your own educational activity. You'll be able to collaborate with your foreign partners.

Small Group Meetings:

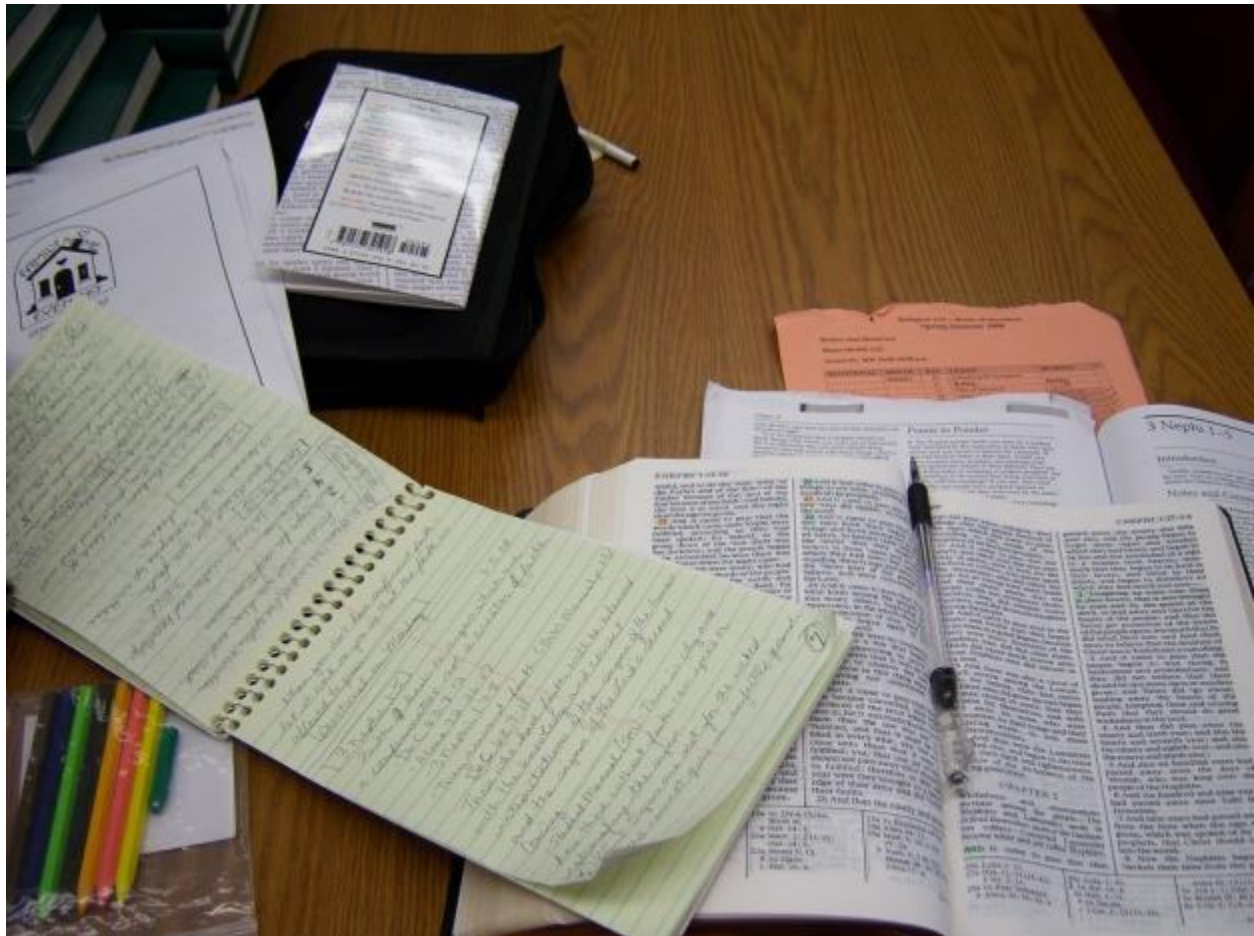
By October 31st: you will organise the first group meeting where you introduce yourselves. Please fill in the "[Checklist Information](#)" and submit it to a [folder in google documents](#). During your first meeting you will explain to your colleagues from Ukraine/Czech Republic how the educational system in your country works. You have to specify the topic within the group.

By November 21st: you will organize your second meeting where you discuss with your colleagues from Ukraine/Czech Republic how inclusive education works in your country (supporting measures, counselling, ect.). **By this date you have to find a professional for an interview.** Please tell your partners who the professional is, what he/she does, how he/she is related to the school environment.

Try to think together about the questions for the interview. [Please save the list of questions into the folder.](#)

By December 11th: you will finish your interview with the professional. Try to reflect on the information you have got (the reflection can be in your mother language). [Please save the reflection in the folder.](#) Then you will organize your third online meeting. Make a presentation together of your chosen topic. You can try to answer these questions: What are the similarities and differences in the field of education? What surprised you? What can be an inspiration for your country? etc.
